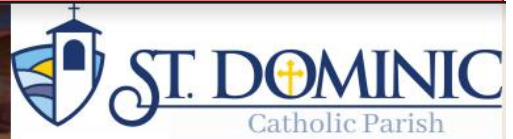
WE CONTINUE TO COLLECT NON-PERISHABLE FOOD ITEMS THE FIRST WEEKEND OF EVERY MONTH.
