### MARRIAGE

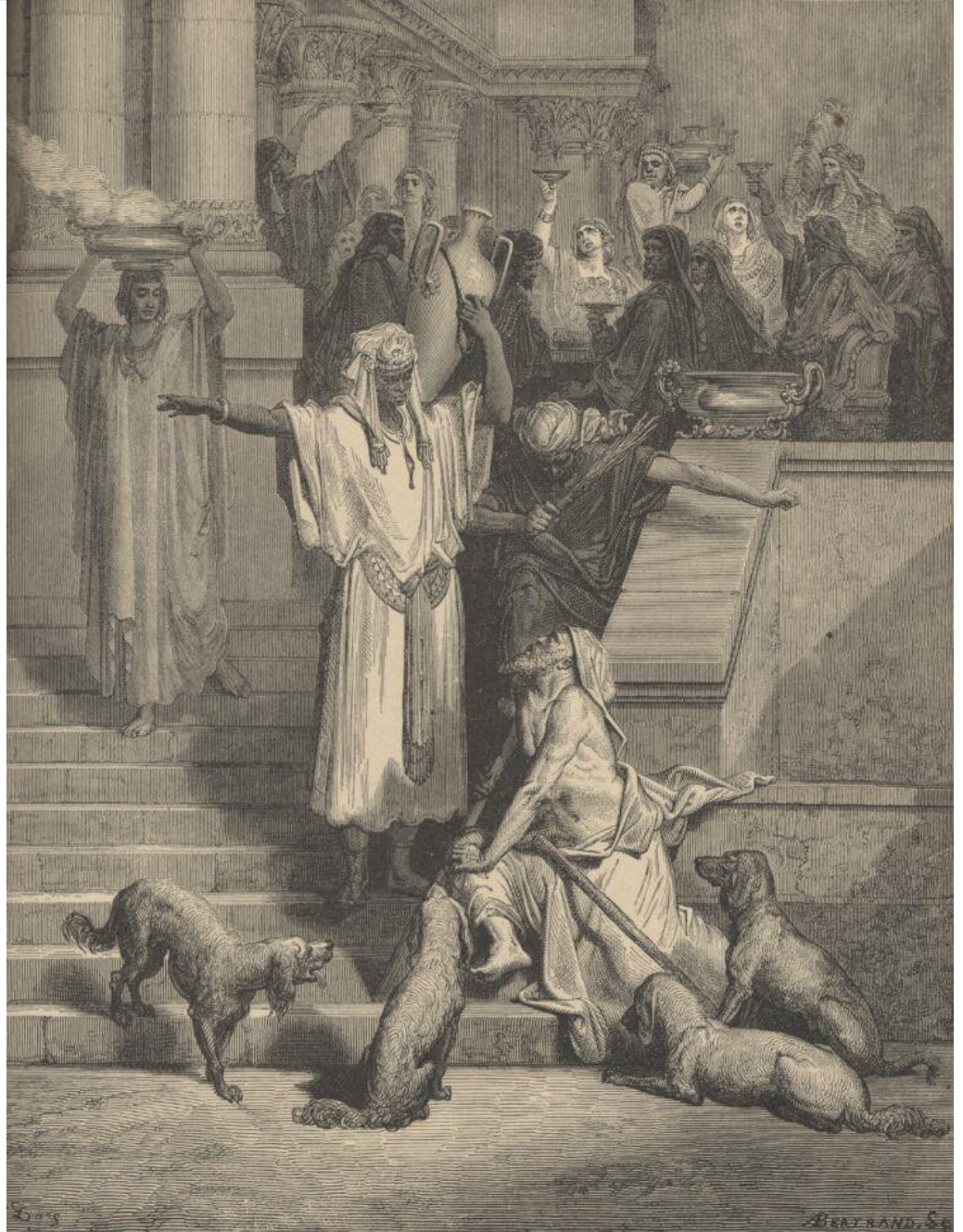
Please contact a priest or deacon six months before the wedding date for adequate preparation and counseling as required by the Archdiocese.
