THE LEGION OF MARY

The Legion of Mary is a world-wide organization of Catholic lay men and women built upon devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. It strives to make its members better Catholics through prayer and service to the parish and community. We have active and auxiliary members. Auxiliary members supply prayer power which supports the active works of the Legion. They are not required to attend meetings or perform active service. They recite daily prayers which includes the rosary. Active members must attend a weekly meeting and perform a weekly work obligation. These works include visitation to nursing homes and individual homes to distribute the Holy Eucharist, the distribution of Miraculous Medals, sending cards to the bereaved and shut-ins of the parish, supporting the sacramental program and any other service requested by the pastor. The Legion can be a powerful means of helping the priest to enlist the co-operation of the laity in the task of evangelising those committed to his care.
