## Food for the Bereaved Committee

The FOOD FOR THE BEREAVED COMMITTEE is a group of men and women who have volunteered to serve those who are experiencing the loss of a loved one by preparing a food item to assist with a meal for family and guests attending the funeral reception.

Committee members can choose to help with one, some, or all of these duties and participate as they are available: set-up, prepare meals, serve, and/or clean-up. No regular or long-term commitment required. Food is typically prepared at home and dropped off at a designated time before the funeral reception. The committee is made up of several teams so that each team is typically only assigned one or two times per year. The families of the bereaved are always so appreciative of the care this committee gives.
