St. Dominic JUBILEE Club was founded in 1990 by Reverend Monsignor Francis Murphy and a group of parishioners who sought to offer senior members of the parish an opportunity for fellowship, entertainment, and travel. Today, we have 166 active members, not only from our own parish, but from other parishes in Mobile County. Our meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month, September through May. We begin at

6:oopm with prayer and then enjoy a meal together followed by entertainment and door prizes. The entertainment varies each month with guest speakers, games, musical groups, or our own Member Talent Show. Jubilee Club members deliver door wreaths or potted plants to our stay at home parishioners at Christmas or Easter. We also donate to Catholic Social Services, St. Dominic School Missions, and Special Church Projects.
