Baptismal Preparation Classes are required and take place over two evenings. Please contact a priest or Brenda Christian for more information.

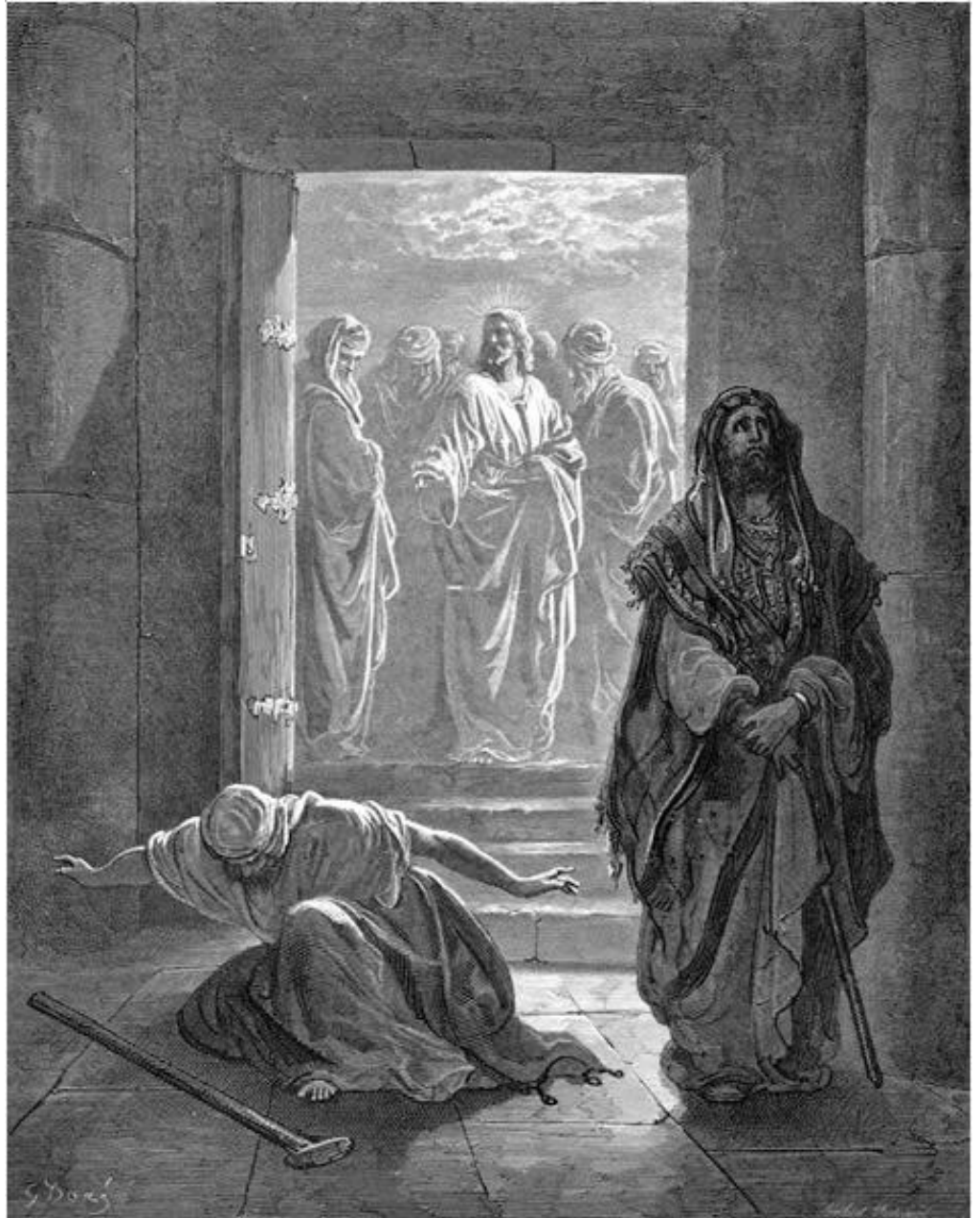
MARRIAGE
