Contact a priest or the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill or in the hospital.

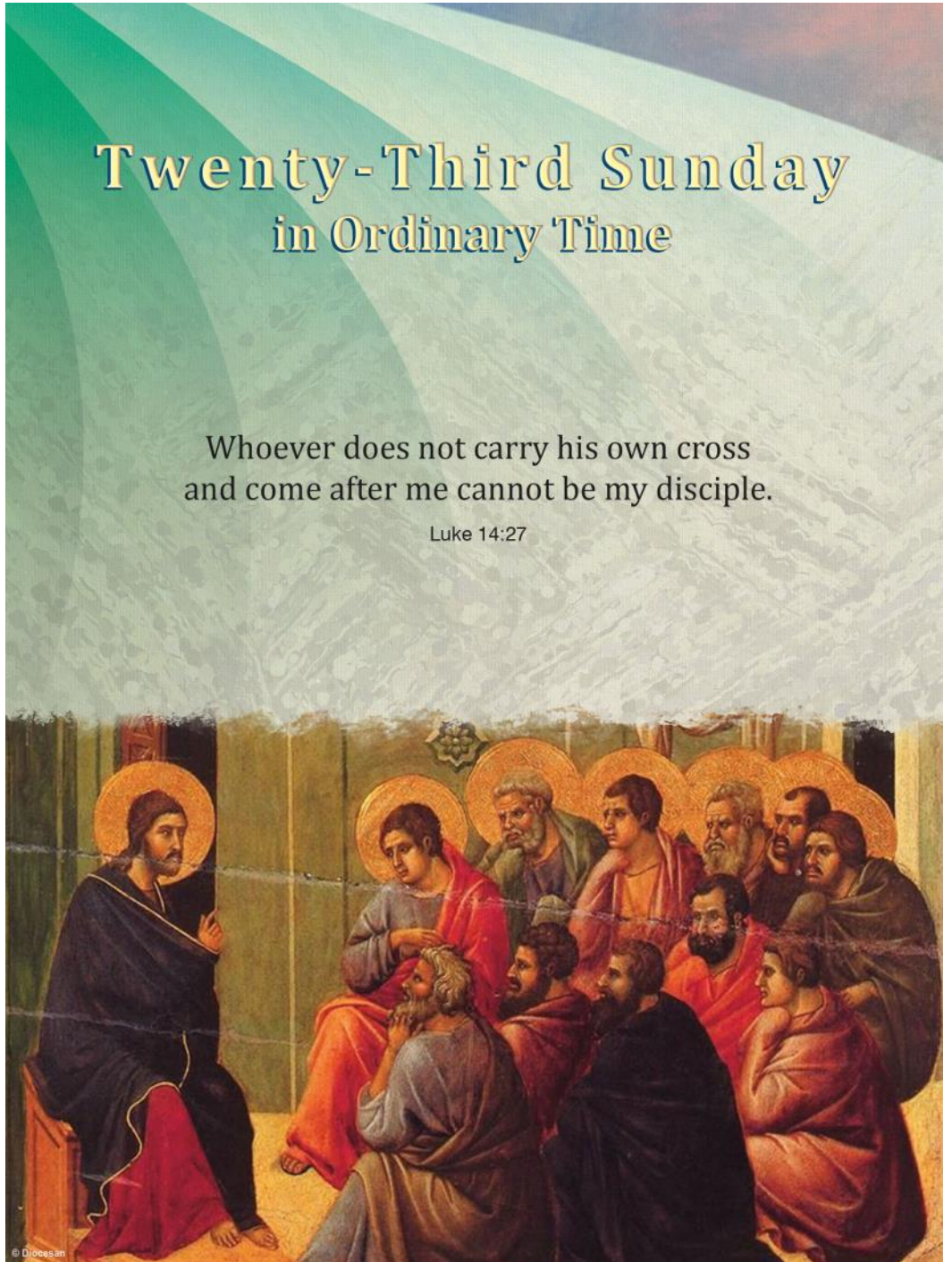
